Rob was born in Bakersfield, California and grew up in the Central Valley. He gratefully admits that he was deeply shaped watching his parents live out their faith, by experiencing the love of his local church, and by connecting with many wonderful people in churches across the Central California District.

After high school he went to Pasadena College, now PLNU, recalling that it was not so much his going, as it was his church and family sending him. His life was again profoundly impacted. He started school as a music major feeling that he was running from God's call. It was on a Sunday night at the Bresee Ave. church that he surrendered completely to the will of God, confessing "I will go wherever you send me, and I will be whatever you ask me to be". Looking back on his life, he says that he has had no other grand plan. He is still just trying to live out the commitment he made that night. Rob graduated from PLNU with a degree in pastoral ministry and completed his Master's work there as well.

It was during those years that he met the love of his life. He and Debie have been married for 43 years. They have three amazing daughters, three awesome son-in-law's, and seven incredible grandkids, at least in their minds. They confess that they love spending time together today as much as when they first met. They also really love, loving their "grands".

He and Debie have spent 10 years in youth ministry, 24 years pastoring 3 different congregations, and now for the past 7 years have been so blessed to serve the churches of the Central Cal District in the role as District Superintendent. During these years God has allowed him to be His instrument to see countless individuals and families, drawn to hear God's Word, coming to Christ and being baptized, finding healing in their lives, and accept the call to ministry.

Rob loves playing golf and traveling with Debie, but more than anything, he loves seeing people come into a life transforming relationship with Jesus Christ, and to see local pastors and churches discover what it means to live out God's mission to see God's Kingdom advance. He says of himself, "When I look in the mirror, I see all my faults, all my failures, and all my weaknesses. Thanks be to God, I also see God's great grace poured out on me, and God's desire to pour that grace through me to those around me. I am simply a very ordinary man who is on a very extraordinary journey."
